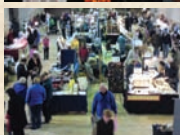

The route to the Hall is clearly marked by Historic House signs. From Beverley (14 miles) take A1035 Bridlington road, turn right at White Cross roundabout then follow A165 towards Hull. From Hull (10 miles) follow A1033 towards Hedon, turn left at Saltend roundabout and then follow signs to Preston and Sproatley.

Access

 Accessible toilets and baby changing facilities are in the Stables Courtyard. We have a designated parking in the car park and also at the front of the house (not always available on event days). The Hall is disabled friendly with wheelchair loan and stairlift to the first floor (maximum 2 people at any one time). Wheelchair loan is also available for the grounds. Surfaces both inside and outside may be uneven and the paths/walkways are mainly gravel.
