Christmas Opening: 23rd November to 15th December open daily

The Hall: 11am to 4pm (last admission 3pm)

The Stables, Grounds, Parkland, Gift Shop & Tea Room: 10am to 4pm

Group options and charges

House, Stables and Grounds (self-guided): £9.50 per person for groups of 15+ (minimum charge £142.50)
Potted History Tour 11.30am start followed by self-guided or accompanied visit: £15.00 per person for groups of 15+ max 32 people (minimum charge £225.00)
Cobwebs and Cream Teas: £28.00 per person for groups of 10+ (maximum 16 per tour, maximum 2 tours) includes Afternoon Tea (minimum charge £280.00, payable in advance)
Capability Brown Parkland Tour: £9.00 per person for groups of 15+ (maximum 25 per tour, multiple tours available) (minimum charge £135.00), or £4.50 pp if added to another tour
'Difficult Women' tour with the Curator: £20.00 per person for groups of 15+ max 32 people (minimum charge £300), 1 hour – starting at 11am includes a self-guided visit to the Hall and entry to the Grounds & Stables
Twilight Parkland Tour: £28.00 per person for groups of 15+ max 25 people per tour (minimum charge £420) – Duration 2.5 hours. This evening event includes supper served in the Stables Kitchen with an introduction and guided walking tour of the Grounds & Parkland.

Pre-booking is required for all group visits, please telephone or email to check availability and make a provisional booking before sending your completed form. Confirmation will be sent when the booking is complete

Admission charges for groups can be paid on the day of the visit, you will only be charged for the numbers arriving, however, minimum numbers must be reached to qualify for the group rate.

Tours including any refreshments must be paid in full when numbers are confirmed 7 working days in advance.

The Stables Kitchen is open from 10am for morning coffees, breakfasts, light lunches and delicious afternoon teas are all freshly prepared and can be pre-booked.
