Life Below Stairs: Join us to discover our hidden Servant's Quarters, the beating heart of this great Yorkshire country house. Explore the rooms not normally open to the public and discover a little more about the people who lived and worked here followed by self guided free flow entry into the hall. **This tour includes a number of steep narrow stairs. £17.50/person for groups of 10+, maximum of 32

Pre-booking is required for all group visits, please telephone or email to check availability and make a provisional booking before sending your completed form. Confirmation will be sent when the booking is complete.

How to pay

Admission charges for groups can be paid on the day of the visit, you will only be charged for the number of passengers on the day, however, minimum numbers must be reached to qualify for the group rate. We accept card, cash and cheque (payable to the Burton Constable Foundation). Any pre-booked catering should be paid direct to the Stables Kitchen.

Catering

The Stables Kitchen is open for morning coffees, breakfasts, light lunches and delicious high teas. It is possible to pre-book light refreshments prior to your visit and if you would like to prebook lunch or afternoon tea please contact the Stables Kitchen direct by telephoning 01964 508167.

Free coach parking is available in the main car park, it is possible to drop off closer to the house by prior arrangement. The coach driver will be given free entry into the house and grounds and a refreshment voucher upon arrival.
